TALL EQUIPMENT IN THE VICINITY OF EXETER AIRPORT

1 Activity

- 1.1 Building construction works involving the use of tall equipment will be taking place in the vicinity of Exeter Airport commencing on **15 August 2016**, for a period of approximately 50 weeks.
- 1.2 Various tall equipment will be operating on site centred on coordinates 504418.43N 032557.62W to a maximum height of 148 ft agl, 197 ft amsl.
